Directions to Oz, home of Seth Stisher's Water Ski Training Center

The address to the paved road out to the lake is 2982 Edenvale road, Johns Island, SC 29457. On that small paved road, you will see signs that say No Trespassing-Active Mining Operation as there is a dirt pit adjacent to our lake where they are still digging.

From the Charleston International Airport:

- Head Northwest on International Blvd, toward I-526 for 1.9 miles
- Turn right to merge onto I-526 West toward Savannah and go 5.9 miles
- Turn right at Highway 17 (Savannah Highway) to head South for 4.6 miles
- Turn left on Main Road and go 6.6 miles
- Main Road will become Bohicket Road as you pass McDonalds. Continue on Bohicket Road 2.6
 miles
- Turn left on Edenvale Road and look for sign that reads "Three Oaks Construction-FILL PIT" on the left after 1.1 miles (turn left and pass No Trespassing signs and through gate until you see the lake)

From Downtown Charleston:

- Take Highway 17 South over the Ashley River Bridge for 0.9 miles
- Take a slight left onto Folly Road (Highway 171)-Signs read "To SC 700/Folly Beach and go 1.2 miles
- Turn right onto Maybank Highway (Highway 700) and travel 7.2 miles then read below, "Continuing from Downtown Charleston (above), Folly Beach (above), or James Island"

From Folly Beach:

- Take Highway 700 (Folly Road) towards James Island (NW) for 7.6 miles
- Take a slight left at the MCDonalds to cut over to Maybank Highway
- Turn left on Maybank Highway and go 7.2 miles then read below "Continuing from Downtown Charleston (above), Folly Beach (above), or James Island"

- After you cross over onto Johns Island, you will go to the second traffic light on the island and turn left on Bohicket Road (may be marked Main Road) then travel 2.6 miles)
- Turn left on Edenvale Road and look for sign that reads "Three Oaks Construction-FILL PIT" on the left after 1.1 miles (turn left and pass No Trespassing signs and through gate until you see the lake)

From Mt. Pleasant:

• Head South on Highway 17 and cross over the Ravenel Bridge into downtown Charleston. Stay on 17 South and pickup with the directions above from downtown Charleston.

From Kiawah and Seabrook Islands:

- Take Betsy Kerrison Parkway back toward the airport and downtown Charleston for 3.4 miles
- Betsy Kerrison will become Bohicket Road. Follow Bohicket Road for 4.4 miles
- Turn right on Edenvale Road and look for sign that reads "Three Oaks Construction-FILL PIT" on the left after 1.1 miles (turn left and pass No Trespassing signs and through gate until you see the lake)
